SUBJECT: Army Modeling and Simulation Awards for Fiscal Year 2010, Call for Nominations

1. Modeling and Simulation (M&S) continues to grow in importance and complexity, and the demands and reliance on modeling and simulation continue to increase. M&S is routinely employed to support decision making, course of action development, mission planning, rehearsal, and operations. To acknowledge the Army's dedication to M&S excellence, the Army Modeling and Simulation Office (AMSO) announces the Call for Nominations for the Army M&S Awards for Fiscal Year 2010.
2. In February of this year, the Secretary of the Army and Chief of Staff of the Army submitted the Army Posture Statement to the United States Senate and the House of Representatives. In that Statement two critical challenges facing the Army were identified. We have accepted those challenges for this year's M&S Awards theme: "M&S in Restoring Balance and Setting the Conditions for the Future of the Army".
3. The AMSO has the lead to coordinate the selection of the top Army M&S nominations; the process and format for the submissions are described in the enclosure. A panel will be established to review nominations and select winners. The Director for the Center for Army Analysis will present the awards during the Interservice/Industry Training, Simulation, and Education Conference held in Orlando, Florida, 29 Nov – 2 Dec 10. We request the widest dissemination to all appropriate subordinate commands.
4. Your contributions are essential as M&S continues to be a critical resource in support of our Soldiers and to provide the critical edge in battle—now and in the future. Thank you for your continued support to enhancing Army M&S capabilities.

Required information includes:

- **Title**
- **Area of Interest.** Specify one of the eight communities; submissions can be entered in only one community.
- **Type of Award.** Team or Individual\*
- **Submitting Activity.** Command, Phone Number and E-mail of POC
- **Lead Member of Team or main point of contact information.** Name, Title, Office Symbol, Location with Phone Number, Fax and E-mail
- **Nominee Information (for Team Award, provide info on each team member).** Name of Project, Command, Name of Individual(s), Title of Individual, Office Symbol, Location with Phone Number, Fax, and E-mail.
- **Description of Achievement/Contribution.**
  - explain how this nomination supports the theme;
  - the level of effort/achievements, and the degree of difficulty or technical problems that were resolved;
  - the way ahead; and
  - anything else you would like the Board to consider.
- **Benefit to the Army related to M&S.** Describe how the Army has benefitted from this work
- **Citation Narrative that would be read at the ceremony.** A short narrative answering what was achieved; how, when, where, and why the Army benefits and if it had an effect on any other program(s); 150 word limitation.

\*Individual must be government employee, however, contractors can be recognized as part of a Team award.
