I would like to take this opportunity to extend my personal welcome to all of the new job series 1515 careerists that have recently been included in Career Program 36 Analysis, Modeling and Simulation. The change in career programs was motivated by the Civilian Workforce Transformation effort announced by the Undersecretary of the Army. The Army Senior Analyst Advisory Board subsequently approved recoding all Career Program 16 (Scientists and Non-Construction Engineers) 1515s to CP36.

Let me state up front that this is a career program change only. The careerists that have been recoded will remain in job series 1515 and will remain in their current jobs. There will also be no decrease in the level of support you are currently receiving from CP 16. In fact, it is our intent to improve the career development opportunities available to each careerist. My office is planning to initiate a series of workshops and conduct a survey to capture your training needs and identify any gaps in 1515 training requirements. My office is also in the process of updating the CP 36 Army Civilian Training, Education and Development System (ACTEDS) to specifically address job series 1515 education, training and development needs.
